

WHAT ARE KNOCKOUT DROPS?

- Knockout drops are usually colorless and tasteless substances
- Mixing knockout drops into other people's drinks or administering them in any other way is a criminal offense
- Knockout drops can be detected using test strips, blood tests, or urine samples

HOW DO KNOCKOUT DROPS WORK?

- In small doses, they initially cause euphoria and disinhibition
- They cause memory lapses
- They cause severe dizziness and difficulty concentrating
- They have a numbing and soporific effect
- They promote anxiety
- They cause discomfort and sweating
- When combined with alcohol, the effects are intensified and can have life-threatening consequences

HERE'S HOW YOU CAN TAKE GOOD CARE OF YOURSELF AND OTHERS:

- Don't leave your drink unattended
- Don't accept drinks from strangers
- Look out for each other and know your limits
- If you suddenly feel unwell, talk to your friends or staff immediately

If you suspect something:

- Go to the hospital immediately or inform the police (110)/ambulance (112) (knockout drops are detectable for a maximum of 12 hours!)
- Have blood and urine samples taken
- Keep clothing unwashed in paper bags
- Make a written record of your memories
- If necessary, document statements from witnesses
- If necessary, report the incident to the police
